## What's on in September

- Design of the internal spaces of Stage 1B will be developed in more detail; colours and products to be used
- Selection of the landscaper to complete Stage 1A will be finalised
- Commencement of the Stage 1A landscaping works (due for completion December 2020)

## July/August Recap...

- Plans for the new Secondary Learning Facility, redevelopment of the Resource Centre and landscaping of the adjacent courtyard and entry plaza, Stage 1B, have been finalised
- The building application for these works to occur has been lodged with Murray Bridge Council
- The process of selecting the landscaper to complete Stage 1A, the redevelopment of the outside space adjacent to the Sturt building into a learning space for Reception and Year 1 students, is occurring
